





1. My child is happy at this school




2. My child feels safe at this school




3. My child makes good progress at this school




4. My child is well looked after at this school




5. My child is taught well at this school




6. My child gets appropriate homework for their age




7. This school makes sure its pupils are well behaved









Additional Comments:

- More communication about homework not being done/not good enough directly to parents would be good. It's hard to extract this information from [my son] at times.
- There can be quite a few fluctuations in the amount of homework received.

- Communication between the school and parent is very good, maybe as a suggestion an app would be good for parents to monitor homework set.
Response from school: *If you download the school app, you can access Show My Homework through this. We will be trialling Google Classroom for homework too in order to see if that is a better system.*
- Frustrating for [my son] that if his target is grade 9 he cannot exceed this target and sometimes will have amber on his tracker if he gets a grade 8. Hence his tracker can be quite demotivating and excludes him from the best tracker awards.
Response from school: *For the most able students with targets of grade 9, we must always push the high expectations. In these very early days of the reformed GCSEs, it is difficult to assess grade 8 and 9 work, so teachers must use their professional judgement. If there is a slight doubt that most able students won't achieve such a high target, teachers have the moral duty to indicate this on trackers. Best tracker awards use Behaviour for Learning, not progress to targets, as this is the most important factor regarding achievement, in our opinion.*
