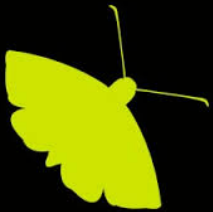
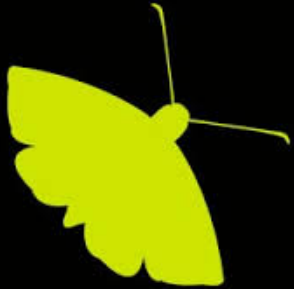

...Draw out every pound?



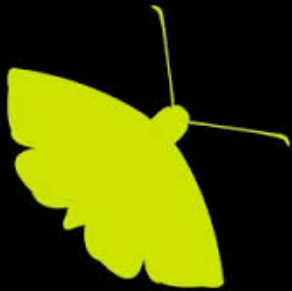
